

Pleasant Grove Sportsmen's Association Facility Safety Rules

Personal Health & Environmental Safety

- All firearms **MUST** be brought into the facility unloaded with the actions locked open until used on the firing range.
- All Shooters, Coaches and Observers **MUST** wear eye and ear protection.
- No Food or Drink allowed in the Range.
- Minimize contact with contaminated surfaces.
- Wash hands when leaving the facility.

Use of Range Safety Rules.

- A Range Safety Officer (RSO) is required to supervise all shooting groups.
- The RSO will close the range and ensure all firearms are unloaded with action open and laid down or in racks if anyone is down range.
- No firearms are to be handled while anyone is down range.
- The RSO is to open the range and allow firing only when the range is clear.
- The RSO **MUST** call cease fire and close the range if there are people upstairs.
- All shooters **MUST** use the same firing line. Use portable target stands as needed.
- No shooting is allowed while the upstairs is being used, however air rifles may still be used if there are people upstairs.
- Firearms are restricted to rimfire rifles and non-magnum center-fire pistols in .17 to .45 caliber. This is to prevent damage the backstop.
- Keep all shots toward the backstop and below the red backstop line.
- No shooting before 7:00 am or after 10:00 pm due to Pleasant Grove City noise ordinance.
- Cleanup after you are done shooting. Remove targets, place brass in the recycle container, sweep the floor, repair target stands, etc.
- Shooters are invited to contribute to the range box to help offset the cost of range maintenance, targets, eye & ear protective gear, insurance, and other costs.
